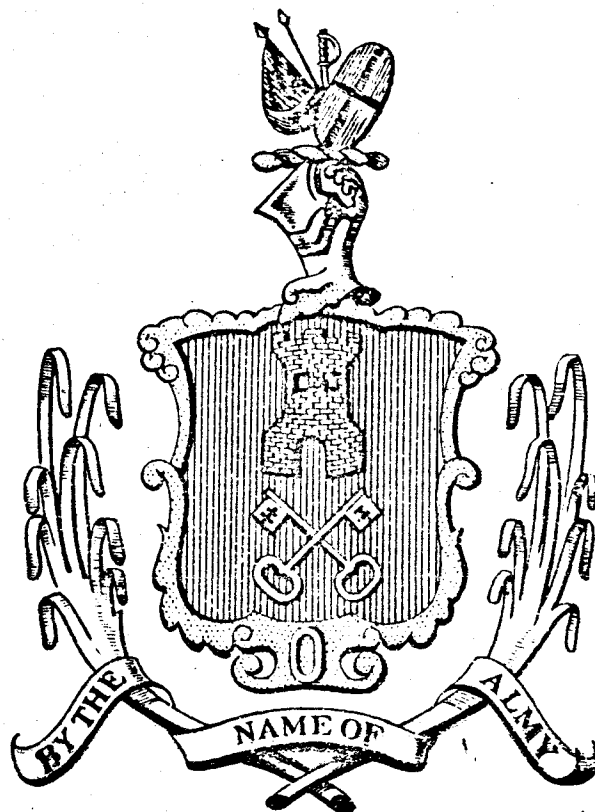

Many of you have supplied me with interesting items for the Newsletter. I will not be able to use all of these items right away, but those not used are filed away for future use. Some items I want to hold until I get other related information to combine with them. In each Newsletter, my objective will be to have a good mix of interesting items.

#### BRANCHES OF THE ALMY FAMILY TREE

This issue will present the third main branch of the Almy Family Tree. The five generation chart on the next page shows the line of descent from William Almy (No. 1) to Job Almy (No. 1408) and his children. Those individuals on the Almy Newsletter mailing list that descend from No. 1408 are listed on page 3.

Newsletter No. 9 contained the chart through John Almy, No. 1407, and his children. Issue No. 10 contained the chart through Job Almy, No. 1233, and this issue contains the chart of another Job Almy, No. 1408. Future issues will contain the other lines; those with the greater number on the mailing list being listed first.

The chart on the following page shows that Holder Almy (1408-3) married second, Sarah Lawton, and that his brother Job Almy (1408-4) also married a Sarah Lawton. These were different women; the Sarah Lawton that Holder married was the daughter of Robert Lawton while the Sarah Lawton that Job married was the daughter of Isaac Lawton.

DESCENDANTS OF CHAUNCEY C. ALMY

In the April 1976 issue of the Almy Family Newsletter I listed the Almys with known descendants that I was unable to tie into my charts. One of these was Chauncey C. Almy, born about 1820.

Loren B. Almy (1407-1074-4) wrote me that "a friend of mine spent some time recently in Salt Lake City at the Genealogical Library. I gave him the list of Almys that you gave in a recent Newsletter that you were looking for more information on. The only one he was able to find was Chauncey Almy, born 1815, with his family including his father William Almy, born 1772, at Providence, R.I. I am enclosing a copy of this record."

I had located Chauncey C. Almy in the 1850 census of the town of Pavilion, Genesee County, New York. In the adjacent house in the census was William Almy, born about 1772 in Rhode Island. I thought this might be the father, but I couldn't be sure.

The LDS church record showed that William, born 1772, married Mary Olney and had eleven children, including Chauncey C. Almy. The first child born was named Stephen Olney Almy after Mary's father. The second child was named Elisha.

I found that I had two William Almys on my charts that were born in Rhode Island in 1771. One was drowned at sea when he was 23 years old. The other's father was Elisha Almy. It appears that William named his first son after his wife's father and the second son after his father.

I have added William's family to my charts from the LDS information and have also added the information on Chauncey's descendants from the census information and what his descendants have furnished me. Here are those added with their Almy numbers.

ALMY FAMILY TREE

In the April 1976 Newsletter (No. 6) I listed seven Almy lines that I had not been able to tie into the Almy Family Tree. Above in this Newsletter I covered the tie-in of one of these, Chauncey C. Almy (1232-1218), to the Almy tree. I have been able to tie in another on the list; Fredrick Chauncey Almy is Almy No. 1232-4139. I have asked one of his descendants, Louis H. Almy in Oklahoma, to furnish additional information about his relatives so that I can chart Fredrick's descendants and assign Almy numbers.

NEUCROLOGY

Earle Vaughn Almy (1235-4131-121) of Cranbury, Texas died early this year.

Mrs. Constance Price (1235-4131-1111) informed me of his death. Her mother and Earle were first cousins and her mother was very fond of him. Constance's mother's mother died when she was a very young girl so she went to live with "Uncle Bill" (Earle's father) and his family. She and Earle were like brother and sister to each other. Constance wrote that Earle had a very full and happy life with much love in his family.
