

THIS ISSUE IS LATE

I started writing the material for this Newsletter on October 1 while in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada. I was too busy during September to even think about what I was going to include in this issue.

In September I finished six years as Treasurer General of the General Society of Mayflower Descendants (descendants of the Pilgrims who landed in Plymouth in 1620). ALMY USED AS MIDDLE-NAME

In the last issue of the Newsletter (page 8), I gave statistics on the number of William¹ Almy's descendants with the last name of Almy and the number that had other last names. I wondered how many of the latter group bore the name Almy by having Almy as their middle name.

I have in my computer 1,864 of William's descendants who have a last name other than Almy. So I had the computer print out a list of all descendants with Almy as a middle name. There were 102 on the list. These do not, by the way, include women who use their Almy maiden name as their middle married name.

Following is the list in Almy number numerical order. If you note omissions in my list, please let me know. Also, if you note that I have a person listed as living, whom you know as deceased, please so advise me and send whatever information you have as to date and place of death. Also, if I am missing birth and death information which you have, please send that on to me. Please note that I do not list birth date for living individuals.

GRINNELL FAMILY ASSOCIATION

I am corresponding with a J. L. Grinnell regarding the Grinnell-Almy intermarriages. We both have computers with our respective family's data in them and we will exchange information as we get time. We both are too busy at present. However, his letter of 6 August 1984 contained the following which I thought I should pass on without waiting for additional information to develop.

"The Grinnell Family Association was formed to serve all who associated with the Grinnell name, regardless of which immigrant they may be descended from, and how the surname may be spelled. Common variations are GRENELL, GRENELL, GRINOLDS, GRINEL, etc. Most come from MATHEW of Rhode Island but a large group comes from RICHARD in Virginia and other people arrived at various times. We only in recent years have reached the point where the lines can be sorted out. We hold a Reunion each summer with the location being a different part of the country each time. In 1985 we will be returning to SEEKONK, MA, the scene of our very first Reunion in 1980. June 28 & 29, 1985 is the time. A book showing the family genealogy in chart form is coming off the press now and copies may be ordered from Ed Grinnell (716-798-2263), 4 Locust St., Medina, NY 14103. The book basically follows those people who carry the G surname due to the massive size that would be required to follow the related lines. My computer DOES follow everyone however and the Association is interested in everyone. Ed in Medina is also the Membership Chairman and he can give information to any interested persons. A Newsletter is published with general Grinnell news."

FREDERICK J. ALMY

FRANK WARREN KNOWLTON, 3RD (1252-9773-323)

Frank Warren Knowlton, theatrical press agent, died 1 August 1984, in the New York University Medical Center after a long illness, at the age of 35. Frank was born in Boston, Massachusetts, on 25 September 1948, the son of Frank Warren, Jr. and Helene (Sigourney) Knowlton.

Frank W. Knowlton worked in the offices of a number of legit press agents, including Michael Alpert, John Springer, Jeffrey Richards, Merle Debuskey, and Solters/Roskin/Friedman, handling publicity for such shows as "42nd Street," "Equus," "Extremities," "Sherlock Holmes," "Bedroom Farce," and "The Ritz." He also represented the New Federal Theatre, N.Y. Frank was a 1971 graduate of Harvard College, and served as president of the Hasty Pudding Theatricals in 1970. While at Harvard he played leading roles in various productions at the Loeb Drama Center.

Frank was a descendant of three passengers on the Mayflower. He is survived by his parents and two sisters. I know he will be greatly missed by his family and many friends.
