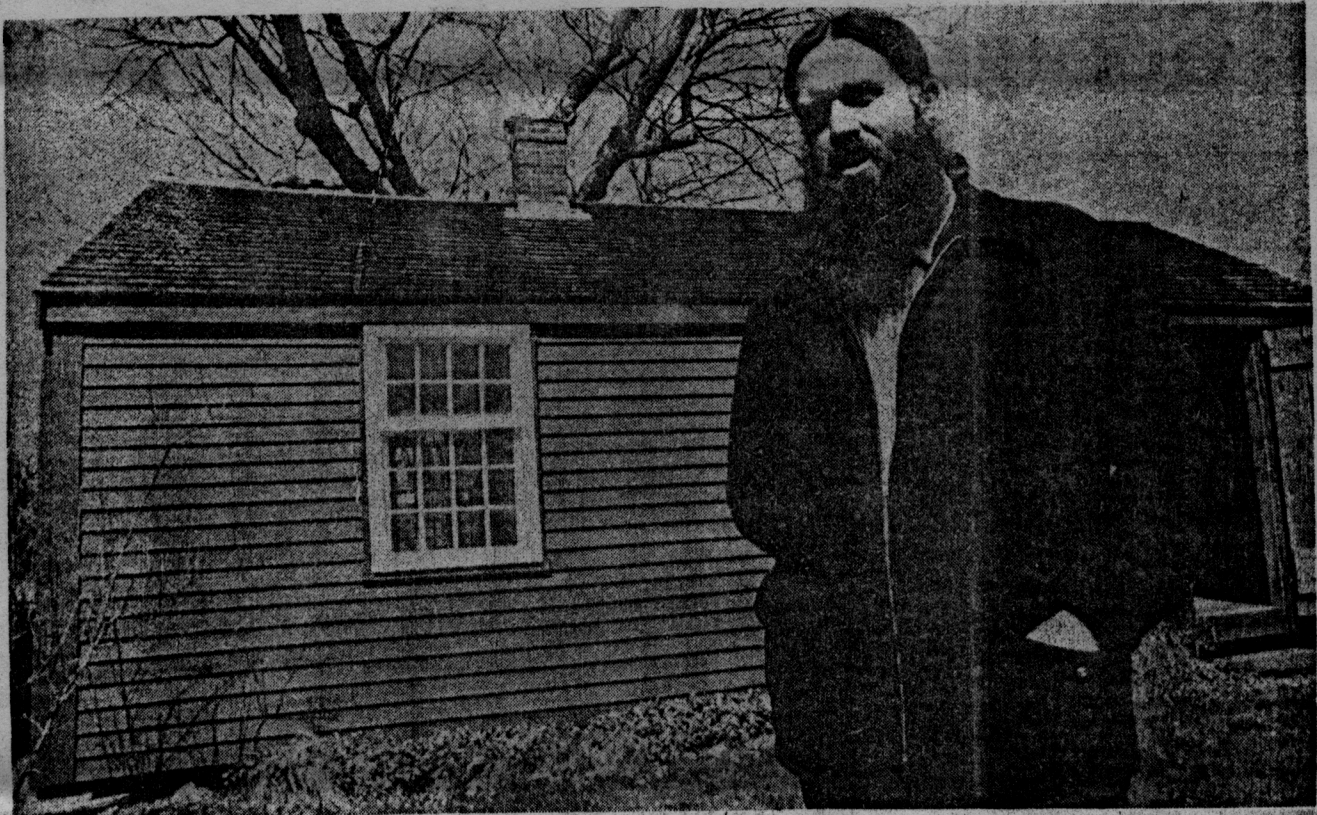

The above information was sent to me by Gordon M. Connelly, a descendant of Elizabeth Almy (number 122, above). He states that the information came from two issues of the American Genealogist.

OLD PORTSMOUTH, RHODE ISLAND SCHOOLHOUSE

Early in May I received letters from Illinois, New Mexico, New York, and Virginia enclosing copies of articles that had appeared in local newspapers. The article was about an old schoolhouse in Portsmouth, Rhode Island and also included reference to Almys.

The article (AP wire service) told that the schoolhouse, ordered built in 1716 and known as "the Southermost School", was restored by Herbert Hall and donated to the local historical society. Hall said that he found the names of some Almys written on one of the old desks. The article went on to say that the Almys were the people that raised his grandfather after he was orphaned.

I called information in Portsmouth, Rhode Island, and obtained the telephone number of Herbert Hall. The Herbert who was written about in the article was not home, but I talked with his father, Herbert Hall (age 83). Herbert Hall, Sr. said that the news article was in error: he was the orphan raised by the Almys. He said that there were two Almy brothers that had the farm he inherited -- Harry and William Almy, sons of Edward Almy and his third wife, Elizabeth.

After the telephone call I looked at my Almy Family Tree charts and found the Almys to whom he referred. Edward Almy (1407-2B) was born in Portsmouth, April 14, 1808. He married first Maria L. Sullings, second Rebecca G. Weaver, and third Elizabeth A. Mathews. Edward died in 1883 leaving wife Elizabeth and sons William and Henry (Harry), ages 18 and 16, respectively, at home. His other children were considerably older and had

left home many years ago.

William and Henry Almy (numbers 1407-2B6 and 1407-2B7) inherited the farm from their mother Elizabeth. Neither of these sons married and the farm was eventually left to Herbert Hall, Sr. who now resides there.

GOLDEN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY

On June 24, 1979 George and Sylvia Nichols celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. Family and friends gathered at the Greencroft Club in Charlottesville, Virginia on the afternoon of the 24th to help George and Sylvia celebrate. Sylvia is the Almy descendant (1233-5147-233). Everyone had a wonderful time at the party and the day's activities provided a good start for George and Sylvia on their second fifty years of beautiful memories. May the years be full and happy.

ALMY FAMILY TREE REVISION

All those that were formerly identified as descending from John W. Almy (number 1407-252) should properly be identified as descending from John W. Almy (number 1239-2145). John W. Almy, 1407-252, was born in Portsmouth, Rhode Island, on April 20, 1819. John W. Almy, 1239-2145, was born (probably in Tiverton, Rhode Island) on September 9, 1821.

When I first recieved the information on the line I was informed that it went back to a John W. Almy, born about 1820. I erroneously connected it to number 1407-252. Subsequent information I have come across clearly indicates that the correct ancestor is John W. Almy, number 1239-2145.
